BSMGC TIEBREAK PROCEDURE

- Reference: Rules of Golf, January 2016 Issue, Appendix I, Part B, Item 10. How to Decide Ties, Stroke Play, Item (c), page 161.
- Ties occurring in the weekly BSMGC tournaments are settled using the procedure as recommended by the USGA since "playoffs are usually not feasible".
- The procedure of "Matching Score Cards" is used in regular BSMGC weekly tournaments as follows:
 - Total score of back 9 holes
 - Total score of back 6 holes
 - Total score of back 3 holes
 - Number 18 hole score
- The above procedure is programmed into the Excel worksheet that is used for scoring all regular BSMGC tournaments every week. In this worksheet, the "net" scores are computed and displayed. If tiebreaks are needed, for example, in "low gross" tournaments, the gross scores can be computed separately using the individual scores on this same scoring worksheet.
